

The Copenhagen Associations Project

This poster presents the *Copenhagen Associations Project* (CAP), the first modern systematic investigation of private associations in Classical Greece, the Hellenistic world, and the Roman East (ca. 500 BC – AD 300). The project is based at the University of Copenhagen and directed by Prof. Vincent Gabrielsen. It involves the compilation of a comprehensive inventory of all known associations from the Greek-speaking world, as attested in inscriptions, papyri and literary sources. In addition to the inventory, members of the CAP team work on a series of individual sub-projects that deal with the various spheres of life in which private associations were active. These projects investigate the characteristics and historical significance of specific associations, as well as contributing to a better understanding of the phenomenon of private associations across regions and time.
